On solicitation DACA42-02-R-BAA1, the following questions have been submitted and answered as follows:

1. Q: Concerning distribution of the Critical Technology Journal - how many copies per year are mailed?

A: Bi-annual distribution of approximately 250 copies for total of 500 per year.

2. Q: Does the successful bidder need to have  
1) A DOD security clearance and/or  
2) staff with security clearance, and  
3) some secure facility to store SECRET documents in?

If so, would the Corps assist in obtaining such clearances?

A: Upon award, the Contractor will need to have a Facility Security Clearance and a SECRET clearance for employees who will be handling classified materials. It is not a requirement that the contractor have these clearances prior to award because only government contractors can obtain clearances. Should an awardee not have the required clearances, proper paperwork to obtain these will be initiated by the Government Security Office.

3. Q: For the classified material, I assume a separate computer that is equipped with a removable hard drive is required. Is this true?

A: This would be covered in the security clearance mentioned above. Equipment requirements would be up to the contractor, as long as the classified material is stored and handled in accordance with Federal Regulations.

4. Q: Do all of our staff need to obtain a clearance or can only those staff members directly involved with the classified material have a clearance?

A: Only those members of your staff directly involved with the classified material, or are involved with managing the classified sessions held at the annual symposia, would require clearance.

5. Q: How much time and money is required to obtain a DOD secret clearance?

A: No funding would be required of the contractor, and the time would vary, but would be the responsibility of the Government to process.

6. Q: My understanding of subsection 2. Journal of Critical Technology in Shock and Vibration, page 8, is that if a group wants to bid on this aspect of SAVIAC, it will be a separate proposal. Is that true?

A: Publication and editorialship of the Journal of Critical Technology in Shock and Vibration is currently being handled by The University of Virginia. The cooperative agreement that is the subject of the current RFP will provide promotion and distribution only.

7. Q: Subsection 1. Journal of Shock and Vibration, page 8. How much money is paid per subscription to IOS Press for the publication of the

Journal? Does this money comes out of the registration fee paid by the participants in the fall meeting?

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The symposium fee would include a one-year subscription to this journal for all participants.

8. Q: I noticed that SAVIAC is not a \*.gov site. So it is a commercial site? Either I would need to know what provider hosts the site, so I can get a cost estimate or I need to know if I can move the site to the same company that hosts our site for cost estimates.

A: The current web site is commercial and belongs to the current contractor. The data on the current web site will be made available for transfer to the awarded contractor's commercial web site. Although efforts are being made to obtain a ".gov" web site, the contractor would be responsible for maintaining the data on a commercial web address until such time that a ".gov" site is made available.

9. Q: On page 7 of the announcement, under the discussion of the Technical Advisory Group Meetings: "The contractor will be responsible for making all arrangements,..." Does this mean paying for the Technical Advisory Group members to attend the meeting? or making hotel reservations and travel arrangements for the members (they would pay for the reservations)? or making arrangements with the hotel to have a meeting, provide lunches, and breaks?

A: The contractor is responsible for providing a suitable meeting place for the meeting that will accommodate all meeting attendees, and that is approved by the SAVIAC Director. The contractor is not responsible for salary, travel, or lodging costs of the TAG members. Past TAG meetings have been held at hotels that were later the sites of symposia, and at the offices of the current contractor.
