ANSI standards. The Contractor shall obtain written approval from the COR prior to any deviation from the ASTM or ANSI standards.

C.6.5.2.6. Workmanship Quality - Electrical Work. The Contractor shall perform all electrical work in accordance with applicable standards contained in the latest edition of the National Electrical Code (NEC), and applicable publications of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA). The quality of workmanship shall always be equal to or better than the minimum specified by the applicable NEC and NFPA standards. The Contractor shall obtain written approval from the COR prior to any deviation from the NEC or NFPA standards.

* C.6.5.2.7. Workmanship Quality - Concrete Work. The Contractor shall perform all electrical work in accordance with applicable standards contained in applicable publications of the American National Standards Institute (ANSI), the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM), and the American Concrete Institute (ACI). The quality of workmanship shall always be equal to or better than the minimum specified by the applicable ANSI, ASTM and ACI standards. The Contractor shall obtain written approval from the COR prior to any deviation from the ANSI, ASTM, or ACI standards. *

C.6.5.3. Housekeeping Services. The Contractor shall maintain all work areas under his/her control, i.e., pumping plants, office areas, shops, storage buildings, and compounds in a neat, clean, and orderly manner. Repair equipment, machinery, and parts shall be positioned so as not to pose any safety hazards while in use. Otherwise such items shall be kept stored in their designated storage areas.

C.6.6. Area and Field Office Janitorial Services. The Contractor shall provide janitorial services each day (scheduled after normal office working hours) for the following Corps of Engineer offices:

- a. Greenwood Area Office located in Greenwood, Mississippi
- b. Greenwood Field Office located in Greenwood, Mississippi
- c. Yazoo City Field Office located in Yazoo City, Mississippi
- d. Marks Field Office located in Marks, Mississippi

These services shall be provided on a five-day per week basis, Monday through Friday. They are not required on Saturday, Sunday, or Federal holidays. Also, these services shall be scheduled and performed after normal office working hours each day. The following services are included in this requirement.

C.6.6.1. Floor Cleaning. Office and hallway floors shall be cleaned daily by sweeping, mopping, or vacuuming, as appropriate for the floor covering, so as to leave them free of dirt, dust, litter, liquids, and other foreign material.

C.6.6.2. Furniture, Pictures, Wall Maps, and Equipment Cleaning. Office furniture, pictures, wall maps, and equipment shall be dusted daily to remove all dirt and dust. This operation shall not disturb work papers.

C.6.6.3. Window Cleaning. Windows and window shades/blinds shall be cleaned once per week to remove all smudges, finger prints, dirt, dust, and other foreign material. Glass surfaces shall be cleaned with an ammoniated glass cleaner.
