C.12.1. Facilities Description.

C.12.1.1. Bayou Bodcau Reservoir Office. The Bayou Bodcau Reservoir Office consists of two separate buildings. The administration building has two offices, one restroom, a kitchen, and two storage closets. The maintenance and equipment building has one office and restroom.

C.12.1.2. Durden House. The Durden House consists of two buildings: one log house, which has three classrooms, a kitchen, two restrooms, front and back porches, and a dogtrot breezeway.

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C.12.2. Floor Cleaning. Floors shall be cleaned each Monday at the Bayou Bodcau Reservoir Office and the Durden House by sweeping, mopping, or vacuuming, as appropriate for the floor covering, so as to leave them free of dirt, dust, litter, liquids, and other foreign material. A "Caution - Wet Floor" sign shall be displayed at all times at locations where floors are wet from mopping. This sign shall be provided by the Contractor and is subject to approval by the COR. It shall be the standard sign used in commercial janitorial services.

C.12.3. Furniture, Pictures, Wall Maps, and Office Equipment Cleaning. Furniture, pictures, wall maps, and office equipment shall be dusted every Monday at the Bayou Bodcau Reservoir Office and the Durden House to remove all dirt and dust. This operation shall not disturb work papers and shall be accomplished using a dusting agent that does not harm the surfaces or cause wax build-up. Glass desk and tabletops shall be cleaned with an ammoniated glass cleaner.

C.12.4. Window Cleaning. Windows, window shades/blinds, and screens shall be cleaned every Monday at the Bayou Bodcau Reservoir Office and at the Durden House to remove all smudges, fingerprints, dirt, dust, cobwebs, insects, insect nests, and other foreign material. All interior and exterior glass surfaces shall be cleaned with an ammoniated glass cleaner to remove all fingerprints, smudges, streaks, dirt, and other foreign material. However, ammoniated glass cleaner shall not be used on Plexiglas surfaces.

C.12.5. Trash Collection. All wastebaskets and trashcans shall be emptied every Monday at the Bayou Bodcau Office and Durden House. Plastic inserts shall be used and replaced any time they become soiled.

C.12.6. Floor Stripping and Waxing.

C.12.6.1. Bayou Bodcau Reservoir Office. Tile floors, approximately 840 square feet, shall be stripped and waxed on the last Monday of October and April; waxed and buffed on the last Monday of December, February, June, and

F.5. RECREATION AREA AND FACILITY INSPECTION AND CLEANING - CONDITIONAL CLEANING. On each occasion of cleaning the comfort stations and hand well pumps listed in Exhibit A, the Contractor shall inspect all other facilities in the related area, including the picnic shelter roofs and floors, exterior trash receptacles, picnic tables, grills, grill service tables, fire rings, as well as related grounds and access road right-of-ways for conformance with the cleanliness standards contained in Section C of this contract. Where the cleanliness standards are not met, the Contractor shall provide the necessary cleaning of these items and areas to restore conformance with these standards.

F.6. PROVISIONS OF CLEANING WORK SCHEDULES TO THE COR. Prior to beginning work under this contract and, thereafter, 10 working days prior to a change in area cleaning frequencies as described in paragraph RECREATION FACILITY AND AREA INSPECTION AND CLEANING AND LITTER PICK UP SERVICE of this contract, the Contractor shall furnish the COR with complete written work schedules, including the time of beginning cleaning and the time of ending cleaning in each area. The Contractor is hereby advised that all work shall be performed in strict accordance with these schedules, and failure to do so shall result in a determination of non-conformance by the COR; i.e., work not performed on schedule is considered work not done and it is nonrecoverable. The Contractor shall utilize the form shown in Exhibit C to this contract in preparing his/her schedules and furnishing them to the COR.

F.7. MOWING AND TRIMMING PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE - MANDATORY SERVICE. The Contractor shall provide mowing and trimming services in accordance with the following schedule. The minimum time spacing shown in the schedule for mowing and trimming applies on an individual area basis. In the event that rainfall, high water, or other circumstances cause a delay in the performance of mowing and trimming in any area which subsequently results in the total number of mowings/trimmings shown in SECTION B to not be completed by the final dates shown below, the final date shall prevail and the Government is obligated to pay for only those services successfully completed during the period set forth below.

LIST OF AREAS REQUIRING MOWING AND TRIMMING SERVICES

Area Name	Approximate Acreage	Description
* Bayou Bodcau Dam	89.4 Acres	Areas to be mowed and trimmed include the open grounds and slopes and the slopes of the dam within the government boundary lines crossing Bodcau Dam Road. Mowing will commence from the shoulder of the Bodcau Dam Road and continue to the edge of the woods. The concrete drainage ditches will be trimmed to remove vegetation within ditches.
South Abutment East	5.0 Acres	Areas to be mowed and trimmed include the grounds from the shoulders of the access and circulation roads to the edge of the woods, water, and inlet channel. The drainage area located behind the comfort station will be trimmed as well as the grounds within the day use area.*

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Tom Merrill Recreation Area	19.9 Acres	Areas to be mowed and trimmed include the grounds from the shoulder of the access and circulation roads to the edge of the woods, water, and outlet channel. The open area on the north side of the outlet channel will be mowed from the bottom of the dam and the edge of the outlet channel to the edge of the woods and water. The grounds within the day use and camping area will be mowed and trimmed. *
Wenk's Landing	4.0 Acres	Areas to be mowed and trimmed include the grounds from the shoulders of the access road and circulation road to the edge of the woods, water, and boat ramp. The grounds with in the day use area will be mowed and trimmed.*
Ivan Lake	4.9 Acres	Areas to be mowed and trimmed begins at approximately 300 feet south of the dam near a turnout on the west side of the access road. Also from that point on both sides of the roadway to the tree line or waters edge continuing past the boat ramp and on to and ending at the bridge on both sides of the road.*
Durden House Field No. 1	1.2 Acres	Areas to be mowed and trimmed include the field on the south side of the Durden House.*
Durden House Field No. 2	5.1 Acres	Areas to be mowed and trimmed include the field on the west side of the Durden House.*
* Administrative Area and Durden House	4.5 Acres	Areas located outside of the office compound fence will be mowed and trimmed from the road shoulder of the paved and graveled roads to the dense edge of the tree line. This mowed area includes the scattered wooded area south of the compound fence. Areas located west of the Ben Durden Road and south of the drainage ditch will be mowed and trimmed to the fence line. Also included in the area to be mowed and trimmed are the areas inside the office compound and the areas between the nature trail and the Durden House as well as on both sides of the Durden House. Not included in the acreage is the spillway area. *

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
