DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The work consists of furnishing all plant, labor, materials and equipment and constructing two low drop pipe grade control structures in Chickasaw and Calhoun Counties, Mississippi. Principal features of the work include clearing and grubbing, excavation, fill, backfill, stone protection, control of water, erosion control, concrete grout for stone protection, and environmental protection. All units of measure are metric.

The estimated value of the proposed work is between \$500,000.00 and \$1,000,000.00.
