The following have been added by full text:

### AMENDMENT 002

**Effective with this amendment the following changes are made to Statement of Work in DACW38-03-T-0010.**

**Page 10 - Add to 1.1.3 - Page 10 "Attendant(s) will be responsible for answering telephone and address/direct the caller as required."**

**Page 13 - Remove section 1.1.14 from original Statement of Work and replace with 1.1.14 below. Highlighting indicates area changed.**

**1.1.14. Interpretive Programs.** The visitor center manager and/or attendants shall present Corps interpretive programs at the visitor center on subjects relating to water safety, boating safety, history, environmental protection, natural resources management, fire protection, wildlife management, and/or recreation management to school groups, civic organizations, church groups, etc. a minimum of twelve (12) times per contract year. Contractors may be involved in the development of these interpretive programs but only to the extent of resources provided under this contract. Programs shall last a minimum of 45 minutes in duration, which may include a guided visitor center tour, trail walk, interpretive program, etc. The visitor center manager shall request from the COR authorization to present or schedule an interpretive program to group or organization who has made a request to visit the visitor center and/or receive an interpretive program or to the general public. The visitor center manager will submit a detailed outline of interpretive program activities to the COR and/or his official representative for approval prior to presentation of the program. Following the program, an interpretive report will be filed with the COR and/or his official representative. One interpretive report form and it's electronic equivalent, when available, will be provided to the Contractor by the COR or his official representative. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to make any additional copies or utilize the electronic form. Corps of Engineers employees and employees of other agencies, with the approval of the COR or his official representative, may also present interpretive programs at the Visitor Center. Inasmuch as possible, advance notice will be given to the visitor center manager of the schedule of such programs to be presented by Corps employees or other agencies.

**Page 20 - 1.4.2.6. - Change "No tractors exceeding 22 horsepower or bushog type mowers shall be permitted." to read "No mowing equipment exceeding 25 horsepower or bushog type mowers shall be permitted."**

**Page 72 - R.1.5.1 (d) - Remove "252.225-7000, Buy American Act -- Balance of Payments Program Certificate". This clause is not included in the solicitation and does not apply.**

**Page 73 - Top of page under R.1.5.1. - c. Change "Summary of Costs and Profits, Appendix J, Question 9" to read "Summary of Costs and Profits, Appendix J, Question 6".**

### **Questions and Answers pertaining to Scope of Work.**

(Q) Is a landscape plan available?

(A) There is a landscape plan available, however, since the Visitor Center is currently under construction, any plan provided during this award process is subject to alteration. Current plan is available by contacting Mr. Gene Davis, Louisiana Field Office, at (318)322-6391.

(Q) Is there a security system of any kind in the building?
