## SUMMARY OF CHANGES

The following clarifications/changes are made to Solicitation No. W912HZ-04-R-0001:

1. The previous procurement for this work was not 8(a) set-aside. This procurement is 8(a) set aside.
2. The approximate start date is July 2004. Reference Section C, page 20, Civil Engineer.
3. Reference Page 76 "PAST PERFORMANCE/EXPERIENCE REFERENCE INFORMATION" and all paragraphs on page 77. The following clarifications/changes are made:
  - The Government requires the information requested on page 76 (1-13). This information should be concise and to the point including the explanations requested in the 3 "Notes" (explain differences on schedules, differences on cost, and describe performance). The Contractor is not restricted to a certain number of pages but is requested to keep all data concise and to the point.
  - Reference Note on top of page 77. This should read, "Use number 12 above to describe your performance demonstrating quality of services and good business relations."
  - There is no specific page limitation to your entire proposal, however, reference Section L, page 77, second paragraph which states, "The Offeror may provide any narrative or supporting material limited to one, one-sided page per contract/subcontract reference deemed necessary for the Government to fully understand the offeror's past performance/experience." This paragraph is changed as follows: delete the words, "limited to one, one-sided page per contract/subcontract reference."
  - Also, reference the third paragraph on page 77, "The offeror may provide information regarding any problems..." and reference the fourth paragraph on page 77, "The offeror may describe any quality awards ..."
  - Please Note: The requirement for the information described on pages 76 and 77 of the RFP is for the offeror to submit adequate data to describe the offeror's past performance and experience. It is not the intent of the Government to unduly limit the number of pages the offeror must use; however, the offeror is requested to submit all the pertinent data in a concise manner. **The offeror is not requested to prepare any rewrites to their technical proposal before submittal just because the one-page requirement for the narrative data requested on page 77 is now deleted.** The offeror could very well list all pertinent data for each reference, submitting all the required data requested on page 76 and 77 on one or two sheets (for each reference). The Government is NOT looking for volumes of text for this particular factor.
4. Offeror's should submit letters of intent for key personnel regardless if they are current employees. Key personnel include: one (1) Pavements Engineer and two (2) Civil Engineers. The technicians and the computer specialists are NOT considered key personnel and do not require letters of intent. Note: Reference the Bid Schedule (Page 5): 2,080 hours equals one man year; 4,160 hours equals two man years; and 6,240 hours equals 3 man years.
5. Reference Section L, Contract Clause No. 52.215-20 (pages 86-87) and 52.215-21 (pages 87-88). Paragraph 10 of each clause does not apply to this procurement.
6. A site visit is not required in order to bid on this solicitation. However, Offeror's may request a site visit by calling Hank McDevitt at 601-634-2075 to set up an appointment. The Offeror is still required to comply with the requirements in Section L, page 89, Contract Clause entitled, "Site Visit".

7. The following changes are made to Section C, paragraph 1.2.3, page 13:

Paragraph 1.2.3 is replaced with the following paragraph:

1.2.3 Primary research and development missions encompass weapons effects; fighting positions; terrorist threat protection; obstacle creation and reduction; fixed facility camouflage, concealment, and deception; vehicle/terrain interaction; military hydrology; lines of communications (construction and repair); airfields and pavements; dynamic modeling and simulation; environmental impact and groundwater modeling; mobility analyses; seismic response of structures; earthquake engineering; concrete technology; structural dynamics; and geotechnical engineering.

Note: The following phrases were deleted from the original paragraph: coastal engineering; hydraulic engineering; flood control and navigation; wetlands processes; environmental site characterization; ecosystem processes; reservoir, riverine, estuarine and coastal water quality; dredging and dredged material disposal; natural resource management. These phrases are deleted as they do not relate to the six technical areas described in Section C.

8. The solicitation closing date remains the same: 23 April 2004 at 2:00 p.m.
