


## ENID LAKE

The Enid Lake Project is operated, maintained, and managed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Enid offers many recreational activities such as boating, swimming, water-skiing, fishing, camping, picnicking, hiking, nature photography, environmental interpretation programs, and a horseback riding trail. Recreation areas contain parking areas, camping facilities, picnic shelters, boat launching ramps, drinking water, restrooms, showers, swimming beaches, and amphitheaters.
