SUBJECT: Yazoo Diversion Canal, Warren County, Mississippi,  
Draft Project Cooperation Agreement Package

1. Enclosed for review and approval are six copies of the draft Project Cooperation Agreement (PCA) package, which includes the draft PCA, PCA Checklist, certificate of legal review by District Counsel, Federal/Non-Federal funds allocation table, sponsors' letters of intent, and Policy Compliance Fact Sheet approved by ASA(CW) on 14 March 2002. One copy of Detailed Project Report approved by MVD on 8 April 2002, with necessary errata is also enclosed. The current Section 107 Draft Model PCA (Version 4C) for a project without disposal areas was used as a guide in preparing the subject PCA.
2. The non-Federal sponsors are not planning any type of ceremony for signature of the PCA, but will plan a groundbreaking ceremony.
3. Supporters of the project include Senators Cochran and Lott and Congressman Thompson. The project is being constructed under the authority of Section 107 of Public Law 86-645, as amended. The Corps allocates funds for the project from the Construction, General appropriation. Funds in the amount of \$150,000 were added for the project by Congress in the Conference Report for the Energy and Water Development Appropriations Act, 2005.
4. I certify that the PCA Checklist and the draft PCA meet policy requirements and have been reviewed for legal sufficiency. I also recommend that the signature authority for the PCA be delegated to the Vicksburg District Commander.
